

Elizabeth House site redevelopment by Waterloo station

To the Rt Hon Maria Miller MP and Ed Vaizey MP,

London Forum was established as a charity 25 years ago and supports over 130 community groups in London.

Our members and trustees have expressed grave concern about the development proposals for the Elizabeth House site by Waterloo station in London. The new structures planned for the site would cause serious harm to views in the capital and the setting of the WHS Palace of Westminster. UNESCO share our concern about the protection of the setting of London's World Heritage Sites and it is not understood why the Mayor of London, Boris Johnson, and the Minister, Eric Pickles, have not intervened to prevent the proposed development.

Please help to prevent the potential harm and the possible delisting of one of London's WHS locations, in line with your department's policies in "Protecting, conserving and providing access to the historic environment in England".
